Become a "Friend Of The Kiwanis Family House" and support its service to patients and families in need of temporary housing. Our new 32-bedroom facility requires significant financial contributions to operate and your participation in this program will help to reduce costs to residents.

To become a Friend Of The Kiwanis Family House, simply complete the application and mail it, along with the \$100 initial membership fee. Annual dues thereafter are \$100. Members are encouraged to exceed \$100 annual dues with a larger contributions which will be annually recognized by the Kiwanis Family House Board of Directors. Because this is a new program and we have a new House, Friends of Kiwanis Family House who join during 2008 will be designated as Founding Friends. Suggested contribution levels are as follows:

- Copper: \$100 - \$1,199

Preventing Identity Theft

We received an education in how to prevent identity theft at our June 18th meeting. Jim Hudson from the Placer County Sheriff's Department was our speaker. He recommended that we pay our bills online or mail them inside at the post office. Putting them in the mailbox at your home or one of the blue mailboxes around town puts them at a higher risk of being stolen. Identity theft via a stolen check is 40% of the cases, stolen credit cards – 30% and stolen credit report information – 30%.

Other tips included:

- Use a cross cut shredder
- Do not put your purse in the trunk, especially at gyms, nightclubs and movie theaters
- Don't carry your social security card
- Don't carry more than five credit cards
- Copy the front & back of your credit cards and store in a safe place at home (this way you'll have the information to cancel the card if needed)
- Don't let your credit card out of your sight at stores and restaurants
- Take advantage of your ability to get a free credit report from each of the three agencies annually. These can be ordered online at www.annualcreditreport.com, or by calling 1-877-322-8228, or completing the Annual Credit Report Request Form at www.ftc.gov/credit.

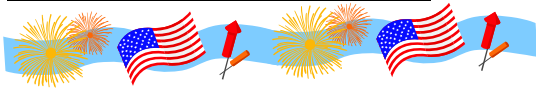

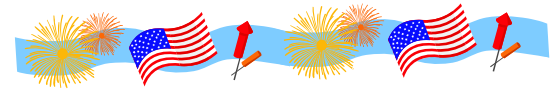
